

Spotlight on ...



The spotlight is shining on Maple class this week. This half term in DT, Maple have been really busy learning about different types of structures. They have focused on what makes a structure and in particular what makes a structure a “pavilion”.

The children have spent the last 3 weeks creating their own pavilion structures out of lolly sticks and air drying clay. They have also learnt that cladding is an important part of a structure depending on its purpose. For their structures, the cladding was used to keep out the rain and cold.
