
The summer reading challenge is always a great way to inspire your child to read over the holiday. It would be great to see Fernhill represented in the medal board this year!

This means orders can be either delivered to you or you can order for Click & Collect from store.

Brenda's will be processing online orders from 1st June 2020 onwards

You will be able to collect your orders from outside the front of our store, all that we will require is your order number, but please ensure you have proof of ID with you just in case.

We've introduced some new service aspects for this summer which include:

- Opening from 8am to 8pm, Monday to Saturday, for order collection
- Making all online orders over £75.00 free shipping

Returns

It's very important to be clear that dealing with returns differs greatly from a usual in store exchange.
