Guidance on School Reopening

These are just some of the measures in place when school reopens:

Drop off and collection:

- Children must be brought to school by one parent only
- Drop off and collection times will be staggered in 10 minute slots. If you arrive late for the drop off or collection time slot, you
 must wait until all children have entered or left. Key Worker children starting on June 1st are expected between 8.30 and
 8.40am and can be collected between 3.20 and 3.30pm
- All parents will be asked to wait outside the school gates on the marked socially distanced spots. No parents or visitors will be allowed on site without a prearranged appointment

In School:

- Children can bring a lunch box and named water bottle only into school. Nothing else is to be brought in from home
- All children will be given a named learning pack containing a pencil, colouring pencils, pencil sharpener, glue stick and scissors. These items will not be shared between children and remain personal to each child.
- Children will be allocated a teaching group called a "bubble" of no more than 15 children. The adults and children in a bubble will not change and bubbles will not mix. Each bubble will have its own learning area in school and its own allocated section of either the playground or field.
- As often as possible, lessons will take place outside
- Hand washing will be frequent and supervised including on entry to school, after play, before and after lunch and at other
 points through out the day.
- All children will be taught about hygiene and hand washing and posters displayed through out the school as a reminder
- School lunches will be a served in picnic boxes and delivered by an allocated member of staff to each bubble. All children will eat their lunch in their bubble's allocated area.
- School uniform can be worn for those parents who wish to but if you would prefer to wash your child's clothes each evening and do not have the time to dry the uniform then own clothes are fine.
- PE kits are not needed. Children are allowed to wear trainers or any other suitable footwear to school
- The school is cleaned at the end of each day and high "touch" areas such as door handles cleaned frequently during the day.

School Dinners

There will be two daily choices (meat or vegetarian option) each day served in a biodegradable box. All meals are served with vegetables sticks, fruit and pudding

Monday: Pork sausage rolls or Vegetarian sausage rolls served with wedges,

Tuesday: Chicken grill or Quorn burger served with chips

Wednesday: Pizza or Vegetable goujons served with diced potato

Thursday: BBQ chicken wrap or Quorn fillet served with roast potatoes

Friday: Pizzini or Quorn nuggets served with chips
