New guidance on the temporary extension of free school meals eligibility

Although children in Years R, 1 and 2 are entitled to Universal School Meals, this is not the same as Free School Meals which children are entitled to if parents or carers are in receipt of certain benefits. If you feel you may be eligible, you can check online at: www.cloudforedu.org.uk/ofsm/hants

In addition, the government has recently announced a temporary extension on free school meal eligibility to include children from some groups who are not eligible for benefits. Please follow the following link to check eligibility and download an application form:

A huge well done to Daria, Aimee and Jayden—our top 3 highest scorers on Times Table Rock Stars this week!


And well done Year 5 who were the highest scoring Fernhill class across the Kite Schools!

Dear Children

Do you remember our assemblies about kindness? Remember the story about being a bucket filler and how, by filling other people's buckets with kind actions, we fill our own buckets too? You can watch the story again by clicking here.

I'm setting you the challenge of filling the buckets of the people you live with. And, when you do, I hope your grown ups will let me or your teachers know so our buckets are filled too! If you need some ideas of how to fill a kindness bucket, there's lots on the last newsletter which you can find our school website. I'm looking forward to hearing about all the things you've done!

Home Learning

Younger children can generally concentrate for much shorter lengths of time than older children. Aim for 15 minute sessions followed by breaks for Year R building up to 30 minute plus sessions and breaks for Years 5 and 6. Please don't think you are expected to replicate a school day at home.

If you can, take a photo of at least one piece of your child's work each week to email to their teacher.

Top Tips:

- ⇒Use the overview sheet as a "tick list" and check off activities as you do them to keep the week manageable.
- \Rightarrow If your child is reluctant, encourage them by saying their teacher is asking for the work to be completed.
- ⇒Please keep in touch with your child's class teacher using the class email address teachers are happy to answer any questions you may have regarding set activities
- ⇒Above all else— don't worry! Try to keep up with daily reading, spellings/phonics and Times Table Rock Stars/Numbots and do what you can of the activities.
