Curriculum Overview

Summer 2 - 2022

English:

Our writing this term will be based around our History topic of Ancient Greek.

We will be writing an extended time line covering how the Olympic games have grown, changed and developed over time.

We will read Percy Jackson and the lightning thief, before writing an alternative ending.

In our reading we will explore the magical book - Mythologica, finding out about the Greek gods and goddesses.

We will also continue to learn our Y5 and 6 spellings and improve our grammar and punctuation skills.

Art: Greek Pots.

This term we will be looking at designs found on Ancient Greek pots and then going on to design our own Grecian Urn.

PE: Swimming and athletics.

This term we will continue with our swimming lessons.

In maths this term, we will be reviewing all the knowledge that we have learnt so far.

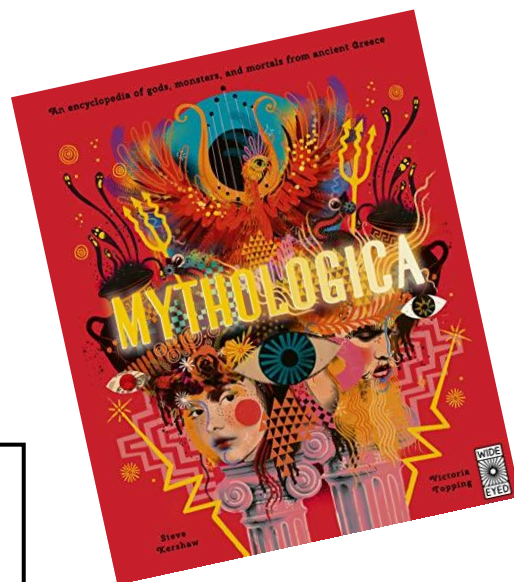
We will be using our skills to help us solve multi-step problems. Challenging ourselves to use our reasoning and problem-solving skills.

These are some of the questions we will be looking at as we explore life in Ancient Greece.

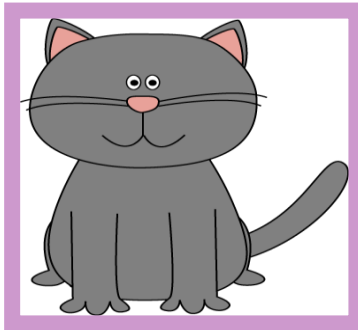
- Who were they? Where did they come from? Who were the Ancient Greeks?
