

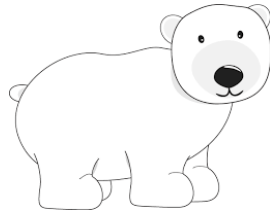

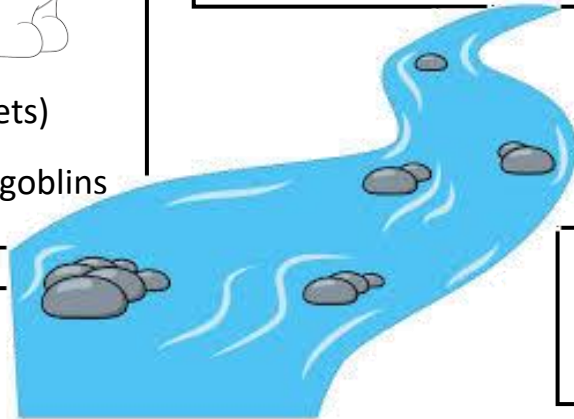

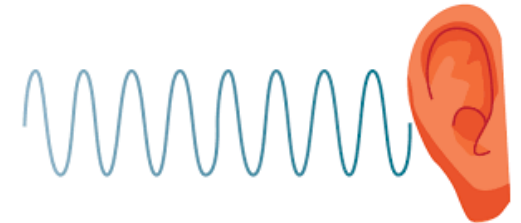

Value: **Co-operation**

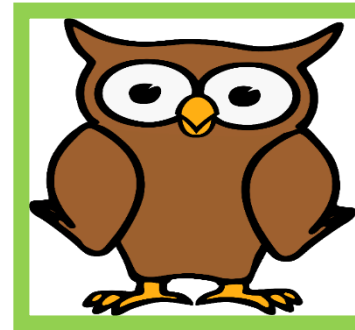
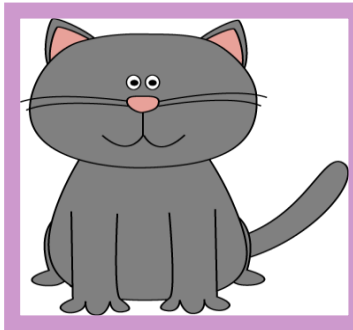
Learning Power: **Reciprocity/Team Bee**
