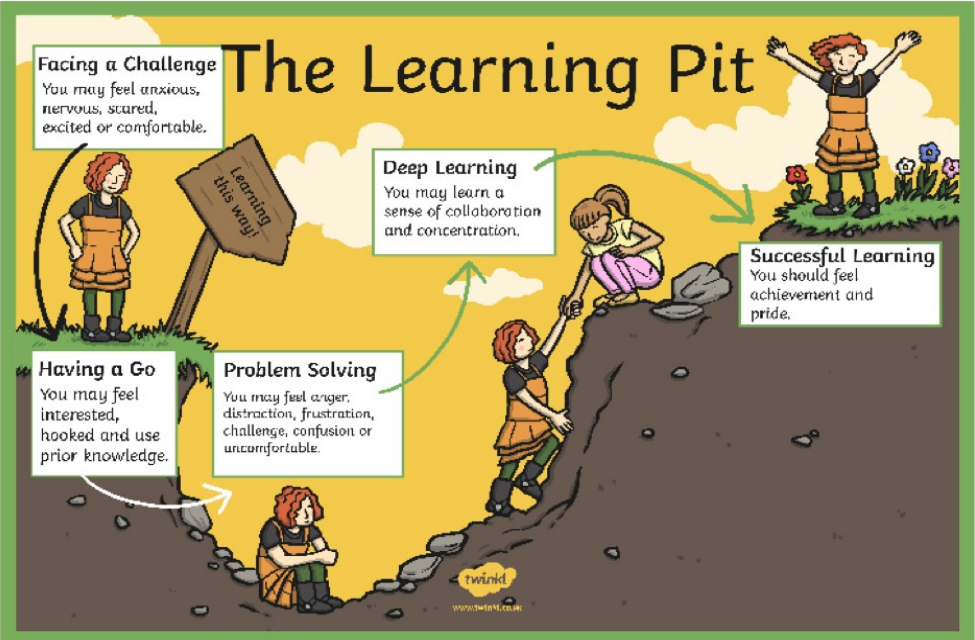

Our Learning This Week:

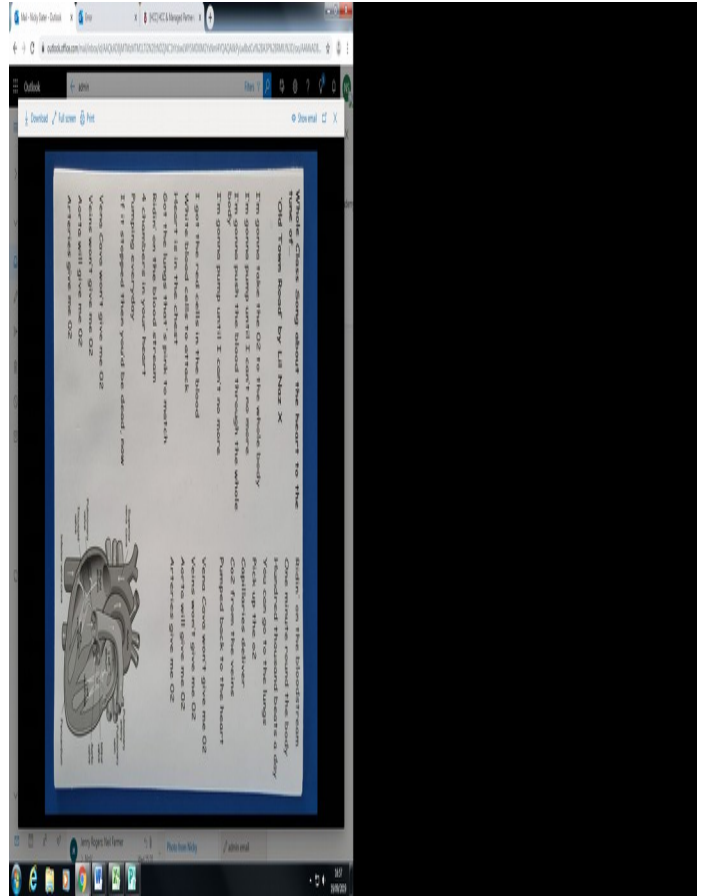
Year 1 and 2 have loved their learning about Traction Man's adventures at the seaside and explored seaside towns and maps of the UK too!

Year 3 have been reading Stig of the Dump and practised writing persuasive letters as well as learning about place value in maths.

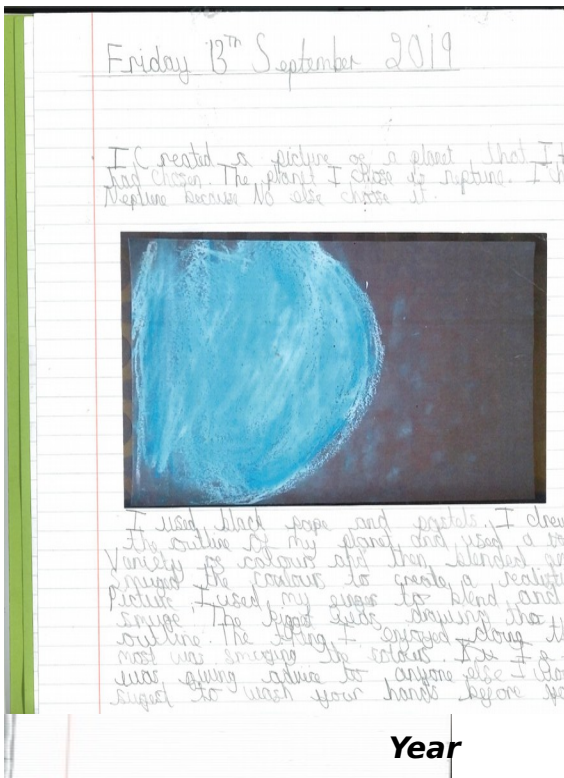
Year 4 have continued their dragon adventures and solved a maths mystery today!
